GOVERNMENT COLLEGE, KORAPUT

By the patronage of Hon'ble Governor of Odisha, Dr. A. N. Khosla, the education development Society, Koraput and Dayananda Anglo Vedic College Management Committee, New Delhi established the D. A. V. College at Koraput the 9th day of August, 1968. It had a moderate beginning with only seven students on the roll.

Today the college is a multi-disciplinary institution with Humanities, Science and commerce wings. The college started IA, I. Com., and I. Sci. courses in 1968. The B. A., B. Com., and B. Sci. courses began in 1970. Honours courses in Humanities began in 1975 and in science, it began in 1977. In 1983-84, Higher Secondary classes began and the three-year Degree classes began from 1985-86. Post graduate classes in Odia and Education commenced in 1992-93. In addition to above courses in 202-23, 6 new P. G. courses were introduced.

The management of the college was taken over by the State Govt. of Odisha with effect from 10th July 1989. In 1989, the college was declared a lead college. In 2012 DAV College, Koraput was named as Govt. College, Koraput.
